TRAFFIC

Parents, we appreciate your assistance in keeping the traffic moving in the mornings and afternoons. Please observe these important basic rules:

- Stay in the proper car line.
- Do not come into the buildings. We truly understand your desire to walk your children to their classroom or pick them up there, but it hinders the flow of traffic. We need your cooperation in this!
- RIGHT TURN ONLY from Spivey in front of elementary building. Do not turn on to Spivey from Gunn Highway and try to make a left in front of school. It will not be permitted. If you do exit from Gunn, you must turn around on one of the back streets and enter the car line.
- Stay to church/school side of roads; do not block streets or driveways. Our neighbors need access to and from their property.
- Do not park across the street and have your child walk across the road to the school property. This is extremely dangerous and prohibited!
- **Please do not enter front parking lot from Gunn Highway.** This is designated as exit only for traffic leaving the school.
- **ALL Kindergarten and Elementary parents MUST use the car sign that was provided at Open House.** Please place it in the front passenger side window.
