Morning Drop Off Reminders

Parents, if you drop off your preschool or elementary children prior to the buildings being opened at 7:40 a.m., you must take them to morning care. Teachers are not in the classroom until that time and students may not be in the hallways or stand outside unattended. If you do not take them to morning care yourself, we will be take them there for safety and supervision. There is no charge for morning care after 7:30 a.m. Also, all parking spots on Spivey and Berkford are reserved for faculty and staff. Please do not park and sit in a spot waiting for car line to begin. The faculty member assigned that place needs to have access to their parking spot. If you need to come to the office in the morning, you may park in the front church parking lot.

IMPORTANT HEALTH REMINDERS

Parents,

The start of school brings the start of coughs, colds, stomach bugs, and even flu. Please remember these important procedures if your child becomes ill~

Students should not attend school with a fever. If your child develops a fever during the day, you will need to arrange for someone to pick him or her up within 45 minutes of notification by the school office. **Please do not send your child back to school until they are free of fever for 24 hours.**

Students are instructed at school as a matter of habit to wash hands frequently with soap and water and to cover their face when coughing or sneezing. Please reinforce this at home as well. **Reminder:** School personnel may not administer any medication for any reason without a doctor's written prescription for it. This includes over the counter medicine such as Tylenol, cough syrups, and even cough drops. Pediatricians will write prescriptions for these and similar over the counter items. In addition, we must have written permission by the parent to administer prescription medication. Please refer to the student handbook for complete guidelines.

HEALTH & IMMUNIZATION FORMS

It is critical that all students be current on their immunization and health forms. A "Report of Compliance" is required by the Florida Department of Health by October 1st for K-5 & 7th grade. We must have all immunization records on file for our students. It is mandatory to have a copy of the child's birth certificate as well.
