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Financial Information 2010-2011

Registration Fees

There is a registration fee for all students. This fee is non-refundable. Current students who register by February 26, 2010 will receive a \$50 discount off the registration fee. Registration fees are paid when registration forms are submitted and are not pro-ratable or transferable.

Curriculum Fees

● CURRICULUM FEE is due June 1. (If the curriculum fee is not paid by June 11, 2010, it will be assumed the student is not returning and the name will be removed from the enrollment list. It will be the responsibility of the parent to contact the school to make special arrangements if the June 11 deadline cannot be met.) Students enrolling after June 1 are responsible to pay registration and curriculum fees upon enrollment.

● **Curriculum fees are non-refundable and not pro-ratable after July 1 and no curriculum materials will be distributed after that date.**

Tuition Fees

● TUITION PAYMENTS are due the first of each month beginning August 1 through May 1. Students attending one or more days of a month will owe that entire month's tuition. Full tuition is paid on the child in the highest grade. A 15% discount is given for younger siblings (excluding enrolled VPK siblings).

If tuition is not paid by the 10th of the month, a \$15.00 late fee will be charged to the account.

1. **Financial Aid**

CPCS accepts Step Up For Students and McKay Scholarships. Log on to www.floridaschoolchoice.org for information. Financial aid is offered for those families who apply and qualify according to the financial aid guidelines. Once the CPCS registration package is completed and fees paid, families may contact the financial office for a scholarship application.

2. **Financial Obligations**

Accounts must be current for a student to attend classes, take exams (including finals), receive report cards, receive high school diplomas, have records released and transcripts mailed. Once an account becomes 30 days delinquent, the student is subject to dismissal from enrollment at CPCS.

3. **Returned Check Fee**

A fee of \$30.00 will be applied to any account when a check is returned due to non-sufficient funds.

4. **Additional Fees**

The following are fees students may incur, but are not limited to:

- **Transportation:** Fuel costs for local field trips and sports games are included in tuition fees. For trips outside the local area, there will be a fuel surcharge. This cost is dependent upon the number of students and distance traveled.

- **Before and After Care: This service is available on regular school days only, no half-days or holidays.**

EARLY MORNING CARE (K3-5th grades) 6:30 a.m. until 7:40 a.m. \$6.00/day

After School Care (K3-5th grades) 3:30 p.m. until 4:30 p.m. \$10.00/day, 3:30 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. \$15.00/day

Extended Care ends at 6:00 p.m. Late pick-up rates: Additional \$10.00 until 6:15 p.m., \$1.00 per minute after 6:15.

****New After School Homework Program (6-12 grades)** 3:30-5:30 p.m., \$15.00 per day.

Students in grades 6-12 not picked up by 3:30 p.m. will be taken to the after school homework program.

No student will be allowed to remain on campus unattended past 3:30 p.m. After 5:30 p.m., any remaining 6-12 grade students will go to after school care.

All Extended Care payments must be kept current. Charges must be paid by the 10th of the following month or the child cannot stay in Extended Care until the balance is paid.

- **Graduation Fees:** These fees are billed prior to the event and must be paid before graduation. K5-\$20.00, 5th grade-\$20.00, High School- \$100.00.

- **Athletic Fees:** Jr. High: \$75 per sport; Cheerleading: \$75; JV & Varsity: \$100; Football: \$175. Sports fees are billed to accounts and should be paid at the start of the season.

- **Intramural Fees:** There is a \$30 fee per sport in grades 3-5. Intramural fees are due when students sign up.

- **Advanced Placement Classes:** AP classes are \$225.00 per subject. This fee covers text and materials and the cost for the AP exam.

- **Art Elective Fee:** There will be a fee to purchase art supplies for class. Prices will be given at the start of the year.

- **Performance Dress Fee:** There will be a fee for performance dress for either choir or band. Prices will be sent home prior to performances.

- **Music Lessons:** Rates and information will be given at Open House for voice, piano, or instrumental lessons.

- **Parking Decals:** Any high school student wishing to drive to school must purchase a parking permit. Permits are \$20 and are effective for the current school year. Student parking privileges are subject to handbook guidelines.

- **Class Trips:** (senior trip, 8th grade DC trip, 6th grade Keys trip, etc.) The prices of these trips will be determined and information will be sent home when available.

- **EXPLORE/PLAN/PSAT:** Explore (8-9th gr.) Plan (10-11 gr.) PSAT (9-11 gr) This fee is \$25 per test.

- **Field Trips/Picnics/Parties:** Prices will be determined per event. Information will be sent home by the teacher prior to the event date.

- **Miscellaneous Fines:** These include, but are not limited to, the following: gum fines, library fines, Saturday detention, In school suspension, etc.

- **Summer School:** These rates will be published in spring.
